

No new Death Sentence for Zolo Azania!

Zolo's sentence was vacated in 2003 after he successfully argued that people of African descent had been systematically excluded from the jury pool. Zolo's supporters were able to help get his death sentence thrown out by coming to court and showing their solidarity. When oral arguments on Zolo's case were heard by the Indiana Supreme Court in 2002, the courtroom was packed with Zolo's supporters. In the front row were members of the Indiana Legislature's

Black Caucus and the Indianapolis City Council. The hearings were widely reported in the local press, including The Fort Wayne Journal Gazette. There were two major editorials in the Indianapolis Star calling for a new sentencing trial for Zolo with a fair jury representative of his community. If the prosecutor's plans for new death sentence hearing go forward, we will need supporters to attend Zolo's sentencing trial in Fort Wayne, Indiana, in January 2006.

- Write a letter to Lake County Prosecutor Bernard Carter asserting that he must give up his plan for Zolo's execution, because it does not serve the interests of the people of Indiana or the interests of justice. Thoughtful and respectful letters are most effective.

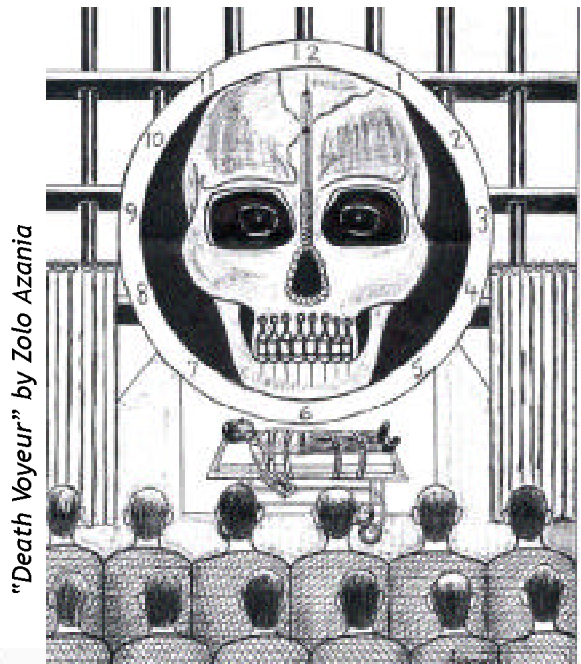
